Meet Format

This will be a timed finals meet for all events. There will be three sessions, run in one 8 lane 25 metre pool, with a second 8 lane 25 metre pool available for warm up and cool down.

Warm-Up Procedures

Eligibility

All swimmers must be registered by August 30th, 2017 at the following website:

Age groups will be done in five-year brackets:

18-24, 25-29, 30-34, 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65-69, 70-74, 75-79, 80-84, 85-89, 90+

Age as determined as of December 31st, 2017

Qualifying Times

- There are no standards for 50m, 100m and 200m events
- Swimmers wishing to enter the distance events must meet
 - o 800 freestyle = 20:00.00

Entry Information

1. The meet is open to the first 250 athletes
2. There is a flat fee of \$50.00 for the swim meet. Swimmers may enter in up to 6 individual events, plus relays

3. Mixed relays must have a minimum of 1 swimmer per gender. However, ONLY relays comprised of 2 males and 2 females will be eligible to place for medals, all other “mixed relays” will be swum as exhibition.
4. There will be a \$10.00 fee for any requested official splits. Official split requests must be formally received by the clerk 30 minutes BEFORE the start of each session.
5. Deck entries are subject to a \$20.00 entry fee. Deck entries will be accepted providing the swimmer was registered prior to the entry deadline of Aug 30th, 2017 and to fill any empty lanes given:
 - a. Cannot exceed the 6 individual events per swimmer and must be pre-registered in the meet.
 - b. Must be in the hands of the clerk of the course 30 minutes before the session starts.
 - c. Deck entries are exhibition and will be seeded into the first available heat/lane.

7. No “NT” entries will be accepted. Swimmers should enter best guess times for seeding purposes.
8. All fees must be paid during the given pre-meet registration times prior to the start of the meet, or go to the Kamloops Classic Swimming office prior to the start of the meet. Entry fees are payable to Kamloops Aquatic Club. We Accept cash, cheque, visa or mastercard

Meet Rules

1. All applicable FINA/SNC/ Swim BC Rules will be observed. The Current SNC swimsuit policy will be observed.
2. There will be a positive check in for the 800 freestyle. Check-in must be completed by 9:00 am on Saturday.
3. Relay name changes must be in to the clerk of the course NO LATER than 30 minutes before the start of the event
4. Meet management reserves the right to alter the meet format, including but not limited to , one or more of the following:
 - a. Limit the number of entries in the 200m events
 - b. Change the start times to an earlier time

5. Spectators and non-accredited coaches and athletes are NOT allowed on the pool deck.

Scratch Rules

1. The scratch deadline is Tuesday, September 5th, 2017
2. There will be no penalty for a "late scratch" in the 50m, 100m and the 200m events. A late scratch fee of \$20.00 must be paid to the clerk of the course if a swimmer wishes to scratch from the 800 freestyle after the scratch deadline. Scratch penalty must be paid before the swimmer races again.

Meet Format

1. Age will be determined as of December 31st, 2017
2. This will be a "cardless" short course meet. However, there will be relay cards.
3. Age groups will be five year brackets spanning from 19-90+, for example: 19-24
4. Relays will be separated by a cumulative add up age. The age groups are as follows:
 - a. 139 total years of age and under
 - b. 140 total years of age to 179 total years of age
 - c. 180 total years of age to 219 total years of age
 - d. 220 total years of age to 269 total years of age
 - e. 260 total years of age to 299 total years of age
 - f. 300 total years of age and over
5. All events (except for distance- 800 freestyle) are timed finals and will be swum single ended. For all events women will compete first, by age bracket, followed by men, by age bracket. Meet management reserves the right to combine heats (age groups) to avoid excessive empty lanes. The 800 freestyle will be swum fastest to slowest, alternating gender, regardless of age.
6. Positive check in for the 800 freestyle must be completed by 9:00AM on Saturday, September 9th, 2017.
7. A coaches and/or team representative information meeting will be held prior to the start of the meet (Saturday AM).

Scoring and Points

- Points for club standings will be assigned according to club registration submitted. The top 8 swimmers in each age bracket will score: 18-16-15-14-13-12-11-10. Relay scoring will be: 36-32-30-28-26-24-22-20.
- For individual events, medals will be awarded for 1st-3rd in each age bracket. For relay events, 1st place medals will be awarded.
- Please pick up your awards at the end of the meet.
